2012-2013 Rules for McDonald's Shootout

ACHA Championship Show Qualifications:

Qualifications for American Championships in all classes are based on the rider's participation.

He or she must meet one of the following:

- 1. Be in the ACHA Top Ten in the class entered.*
- 2. Show at least 4 times in the same class held by the same Affiliate.*
- 3. Show at least 8 times in the same class at any Affiliate.*
- 4. A rider qualified for the Championships may qualify to show in additional classes by showing 1 time in an approved class at any Affiliate providing the horse and rider are eligible for that class. No rider may enter the Championships on a horse that they have not shown at least once during the point year. The rider must have shown that horse at least once in every class entered at the Championships. A rider may enter any horse that he or she has shown at least one time in the specific class entered. ***(No qualification needed for aged events)***

Expo Arena consists of warm up area, alley and show pen

1. Only horses and riders who have qualified under current ACHA rules may enter Championship Show. The ACHA staff will check all entries. Horses and riders entered in the limited age events held in conjunction with the Championship Show do not have to qualify.
2. Entries for **Aged Events and All Regular Show Classes** must be postmarked by September 5, 2013. There will be NO grace period. Credit Cards **will not** be accepted.
3. All entries which have not paid entry fees at the time of the draw will be cancelled and not in the draw.
4. Late entries for **Limited Aged Events and All Regular Weekend Classes** will be accepted until 8 AM on the first day of a class, with a \$100.00 late fee penalty. Any entries made after the draw will work last in a bunch. The Draw will be at 12 Noon on Tuesday September 17, 2013.

VET CHECK – THE EYE OF THE HORSE.....by Jennifer Bowers, DVM

The horse's eye is an amazing organ, and good vision is especially important in the cutting horse. Eye care is often something that many horse owners take for granted, and little do they know how critical it is that seemingly minor eye injuries be treated promptly and aggressively when they do occur. The horse's eye is much more reactive than most other animal species, and it is not uncommon for a relatively minor eye injury to "go south" in a hurry if treatment is delayed for even a few hours. I encourage prompt medical treatment for any eye injury, and the outcome is usually much better, as well as much less expensive, than if the owner takes a "let's wait a few days and see what happens on its own" attitude. Even minor injuries to the horse's eye can become infected within a few hours, with the result being possibly permanent scarring or even loss of the eye. I recommend that horse owners keep in their Equine First Aid Kit the following items, most of which they can purchase from their regular veterinarian, to keep on hand in the event of an eye injury, so that prompt treatment can begin...of course, I still recommend that the horse be examined by their veterinarian as soon as possible (but we all know that most horse injuries occur on nights or weekends, or when you're off at a show)...

- Banamine, preferably for IV use, but oral does work if you are not comfortable giving IV injections
- Sterile eye wash or saline solution. Plain ophthalmic antibiotic ointment, sterile, and WITHOUT steroids of any kind, such as hydrocortisone, dexamethasone, prednisone, etc.
- Fly mask

Armed with these four items, stored in your trailer First Aid Kit, you can effectively treat most minor eye injuries quickly, and greatly enhance the chances of a full and speedy recovery with a great outcome. The anti-inflammatory properties of Banamine are extremely important, not to mention that your horse will appreciate the pain relief...eye injuries hurt!!! The eye wash or saline, in a squeeze bottle, can be used to flood the eye, and flush out any debris, bits of hay, or other foreign material. The antibiotic ointment, usually a triple antibiotic ointment, can be started to treat and prevent infection until your vet can examine the eye more closely. The fly mask will help protect the eye and make the horse more comfortable without wind blowing in the already injured eye, as well as preventing flies from being attracted to the watery or goopy eye! Additionally, I always recommend using a fly mask on all horses while trailering, to protect the eyes from bugs or shavings, which can easily blow into their eyes. This is especially important in warm weather, when the windows are normally dropped down, even if there are window bars. Window screens do offer more protection than do the bars, but even shavings can blow around in the trailer and irritate their eyes, so I prefer to use fly masks year 'round for trailering.

One last precautionary bit of advice pertains to the statement above, concerning eye ointment. NEVER, EVER use ANY ointment (or drops) that contain any form of steroid or cortisone in the eye unless your veterinarian has examined the eye and instructs you to do so!!! I have seen this needless tragedy unfold on several occasions, where the owner just happened to have a leftover tube of eye ointment that contained steroid, and began treating a new eye injury with the ointment containing steroid....which actually is MUCH worse than doing no treatment at all...with the result of a permanently lost eye. Because horses' eyes are so very reactive, it is much better for you, your horse, and your pocketbook to have any equine eye injury examined by your veterinarian promptly and without delay!

I sincerely hope that these eye care and trailering tips are of help to you and your horse, and remember that "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure"...especially when it comes to eyes!
